

Advanced Placement (AP) Course Exams

Advanced Placement (AP) courses are college courses taught in our high schools. Students who choose to take the College Board AP Exam at the end of the year may receive college credit. Many Green Bay Public School graduates have begun college with twenty or more credits because of scoring well on AP Exams. With the escalating cost of college tuition, this is a significant advantage. In addition, taking AP courses and exams prove to college admission officers that the student is willing to do college level work.

The window for registering for AP Exams is February 20 through March 2. Each exam costs \$87. Students are required to pay a \$15 deposit at the time they register in their high school office.
