

Scheduling for the 2010-2011 School Year

All current Preble 9th, 10th, and 11th graders will be scheduling for the 2010-2011 school in December, 2009. We will be using the following schedule to distribute scheduling materials to the students during their Language Arts classes in the auditorium.

- December 7th - Current 11th graders will receive materials.
- December 8th – Current 10th graders will receive materials.
- December 11 – Current 9th graders will receive materials.

Parents are invited to attend these informational sessions (you are welcome to attend any session on the day that your child is receiving their scheduling materials; you do not have to attend the specific hour that your child has Language Arts). Students will be receiving a current transcript, scheduling sheet, and an abbreviated course description book. This book will have programs, policies and the lists of classes offered in the GBAPS. The entire book will be available online for student and parent viewing. The abbreviated book is one example of how the district is trying to “go green”.

The students will be asked to take the materials home to discuss with parents and return them to school. Parents are asked to sign the back of the course selection sheet; this is our way of knowing that you approve of the selections indicated on the sheet. We will be meeting with students in the computer labs this year and scheduling with them online; this is a new part of our scheduling process this year. We are asking that all students be ready for the online registration by following the guidelines indicated below. One extra note; if a student is enrolling in an Advanced or AP class their current teacher in that particular subject area should initial the course selection sheet.

Students will report to the computer labs in the Language Arts classes according to the following schedule.

- December 14th – Current 11th graders will register for classes.
- December 15th – Current 10th graders will register for classes.
- December 16th – Current 9th graders will register for classes.
